Construction activity related to the Trans Mountain Expansion Project is underway in your region.



Worker Conduct



### **Off-Duty Worker Language**

Trans Mountain has followed up with the contractor regarding the importance and expectation of good worker conduct when off duty. All contractors are required to have and enforce a worker code of conduct.





#### Noise, Vibration from Trucks

Trans Mountain will follow up on noise/vibration and traffic-related complaints to confirm their relation to Project activity. The contractor's Traffic Management Plan addresses public protection measures, access roads/routes to the construction site and Traffc Control Plans for each work zone, while considering potential impacts with mitigation.
